According to a Recent
Statewide Poll of Registered
Michigan Voters:

Voters Overwhelmingly Support
Community-Based Alternatives For
Justice-Impacted Youth

The Breakdown

93% of respondents agree that community-based alternatives, such as drug use treatment, counseling, and family therapy should be available to youth in the juvenile justice system.



76% of respondents support the reallocation of resources for detention or residential placement to alternative approaches such as community-based programs or counseling.
