The Breakdown

78%

of respondents agree that elected officials in the Michigan State legislature have a responsibility to pass legislation that provides youth in the juvenile defense system the same resources that adults in the defense system receive.



68%

of respondents agree that providing public defenders to children in the juvenile justice system can help reduce racial disparities.

The Take Away

After hearing that the legislation could reduce re-offending and provide juveniles with the help they need to become successful members of society, 77% of respondents indicated they are more likely to support the Michigan Indigent Defense Commission legislation.
