Voters Overwhelmingly Support  
Workforce Development Programming  
For Justice-Impacted Youth

## The Breakdown

**92%** of respondents agree that to promote safe communities - give workforce development opportunities.



**83%** of respondents agree that workforce development programs are preventative and rehabilitative care.



**85%** of respondents support state policymakers funding new workforce programming for at-risk or involved youth.



**88%** of respondents agree that giving youth at risk of JJ involvement workforce opportunities promote safer communities.
